I, FLAVIA FELICIANO, declare that the following statement is true and correct:

1. My name is Flavia Feliciano.

2. I am over the age of eighteen (18) and competent to make this declaration.

3. I am a resident of Hermiston in Umatilla County, OR.

4. I worked at St. Michelle Wine Estate for four and a half years as a Quality Improvement Technician.

5. I became unemployed on August 28th, 2019.

6. I applied for unemployment benefits on in October of 2019.

7. My claim was in adjudication for several weeks. I was

denied because of misconduct, but you appealed and won with the help from the Unemployment Law Project.

8. I started receiving benefits in early February, and received benefits through May 9th, 2020, when ESD didn't pay me.

9. On May 17th, 2020, they sent you a notification stating that I needed to verify my identity. I replied the same day, sending my driver's license and social security card.

10. Since then, my claim has been in adjudication and my account says, "payment pending." I've been waiting five weeks now, and I haven't received any payment.

11. I've tried calling ESD at least a hundred times. Every day, I try calling early in the morning, late in the afternoon, and at night, but I've only received messages saying that I need to call back another time without letting me through. I have not spoken with a representative. I've sent ten messages or so through my electronic account over the course of the last five weeks, but I have not received any response.

12. I have been significantly and adversely affected in the following ways due to my not receiving my unemployment benefits: I have no money at all. I am so broke. I can't pay my rent for June, I can't pay my bills. I can't pay my rent, my power bills, my water, my phone bills... I had to borrow money for gas and food. I am in limbo because I can't apply for food stamps because I am technically supposed to receive unemployment, but I haven't received any money yet. I cannot pay my blood pressure medication this month, so I can't receive it. My car need an oil change and light bulbs, but I have no money to pay for that either. Currently, my driver's license is suspended (for a traffic ticket, which I can't pay) and I would need to pay to get it back, but I don't have money to do that.

13. On a scale of 1-10 my level of fear and stress is a 10. I've been in tears. It's so frustrating to not have answers or explanations as to why my money is being withheld. I assume it's a fraud thing, but they

haven't officially told me that yet, so I'm still in the dark. Right now, knowing nothing is very stressful. It's not fair that they would just stop sending money cold turkey without any explanation whatsoever. I don't know how it's legal to get away with that.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my Knowledge.
